

Press Note

Bhopal dated 25 February 2010

The **Finance Minister Shri Raghavji** has presented the budget for the year 2010-11 today.

The salient features of the budget are as follows:-

- Total expenditure of Rs. 51,507.31 crore for the year 2010-11.
- Revenue Surplus of Rs. 1580.56 crore.
- ♦ Fiscal deficit for year 2010-11 is estimated to be Rs. 8003.03 crore and it is 4 percent of GSDP.
- ♦ Targets set under the Rajkoshiya Uttardayitva Avam Budget Prabandhan Adhiniyam, 2005 are expected to be achieved.
- ♦ Total revenue receipts for the year 2010-11 are estimated to be Rs 43443.82 crore. Components of revenue receipts are Rs 18670.18 crore state's own tax revenue; Rs. 11047.41 crore share in central taxes; Rs. 4322.46 crore state's non tax revenue and Rs. 9403.77 crore of central grants.
- ♦ State's own tax revenue estimates are 16.14 percent higher in 2010-11(BE) as compared to 2009-10 (BE).
- ♦ Revenue expenditure of Rs. 41863.26 crore has been estimated for the year 2010-11, which is Rs. 3601.14 crore higher as compared to budget estimates of Rs. 38262.12 crore for the year 2009-10.
- ♦ Opening balance of Rs.(-)191.02 crore is estimated for the year 2010-11. Net transactions during the year are anticipated to be Rs. (+) 63.28 crore. Hence, closing balance at the end of the year is estimated to be Rs.(-) 191.02 crore.
- ♦ Estimated Plan expenditure for the year 2010-11 is Rs. 21939.12 crore as against Rs. 19028.03 crore for the year 2009-10, which is 15.30 percent higher than the previous year.
- ♦ Budget estimates in Tribal sub-plan has been increased from Rs. 3869.03 crore for the year 2009-10 to Rs. 4090.77 crore for the year 2010-11, which is 5.72 percent higher than the budget estimates for the year 2009-10
- ♦ Budget estimates in Scheduled Caste sub-plan has been increased from Rs. 2496.85 crore for the year 2009-10 to Rs. 2748.90 crore for the year 2010-11, which is 10.09 percent higher than the budget estimates for the year 2009-10.

Fiscal Indicators

- ♦ Ratio of Revenue surplus to GSDP is 0 .79 percent.
- ♦ Ratio of Interest payments to Total Revenue Receipts is 11.63 percent.
